

Popcorn Treat Correction!

Two lines of type were reversed in the "Popcorn Treat" recipe printed in the January 30, 1968 issue of Capper's Weekly, making the ingredients hard to follow. The recipe should have read:

Combine 1 cup brown sugar, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup light corn sirup, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup water, 2 tablespoons vinegar, 2 tablespoons butter. Cook to very hard ball stage. When nearly done, add $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon soda. Pour sirup mixture over 12 cups warm popped corn very lightly salted. Mix and bake in oven a little while, stirring often, until all kernels are evenly coated. Spread out on buttered surface to cool. Peanuts may be added if you wish.
